The purpose of the grant is to provide dance/movement and music experiences to all students in a way that will support instruction in Math, Social Studies, and Civics concepts. Students will be able to make connections by learning how dance and music is structured using beats, rhythms, and tempo. Through creative choreography, students will experience counting sets of beats(multiplication) in very actively engaging and motivating activities. The folk dances, and social dances from various historical eras that will be taught will provide a natural connection to historic awareness and civic pride. All students will be developmentally engaged in playing American marching band percussion instruments focusing on the concepts of beat, rhythm, tempo, and simple music notation. Throughout all instruction, math will be a focus. At the end of the year, students will demonstrate their skills by performing for their parents.

Briefly list grant program activities (what is going to be done with the grant funds):
The EdExploreSRQ program "Dancing Through the Decades", focusing on the Revolutionary era will be provided for all 4th and 5th grade students. All students in grades K-3 will learn folk dances and social dances in Music classes. Percussion instruments will be purchased for the entire school population to use in Music class.

- Paying the professional dance instructor
