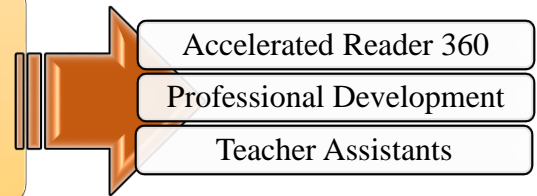
Our Vision

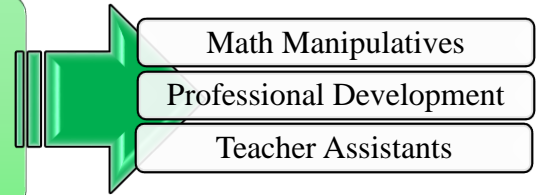
Reading - Increase proficiency by 7%

- Grades 3-5 will increase from 42% to 49%
- Grades 6-8 will increase from 45% to 52%



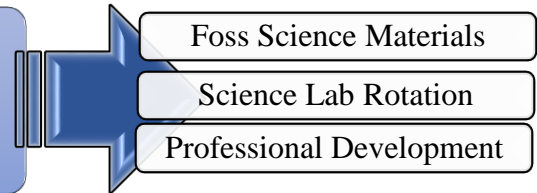
Math - Increase proficiency by 7%

- Grades 3-5 will increase from 36% to 43%
- Grades 6-8 will increase from 33% to 40%



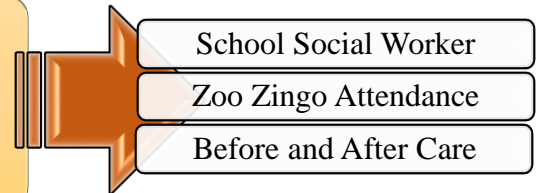
Science - Increase proficiency by 7%

- Grades 5 and 8 will increase from 28% to 35%



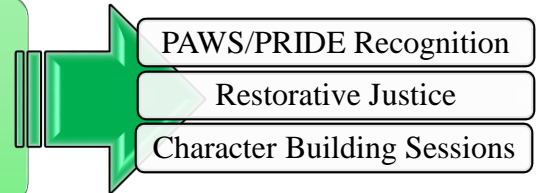
Attendance - Students below 90%

- Grades K-8 will decrease from 34% to 24%



Behavior - One or more suspensions

- Grades K-8 will decrease from 24% to 14%



Parent Involvement - 10% increase

- SSIS parental involvement will increase from 65% to 75%
