Information Required for Gifted Eligibility Determination for Students Moving to Sarasota County 2011-2012 School Year

Your child's district school requires the items listed below in order to determine eligibility for the Sarasota County's Gifted Program. Eligibility will be determined at your child's district school, upon receipt and approval of the following:

- Proof of residency in Sarasota County
- Licensed psychologist's evaluation reporting IQ <u>and</u> academic achievement test scores, if interested in Pine View or full-time Gifted Cluster Sites
- Gifted characteristics rating scales
- Report card grades, spanning one year
- For Acceptance of Files:

 Proof of residency, in Sarasota
 County, must be established by deadline date, June 5, 2012.

 Examples: recent utility bill, lease agreement

2. Evaluation Report:

By licensed psychologist or school psychologist that includes both

psychologist that includes both individual IQ and academic achievement testing.

IQ Test

- Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children, Fourth Edition (WISC-IV) or
- Stanford-Binet Intelligence Scale-Fifth Edition (SB5)
- Or other acceptable IQ measures

The minimum required IQ score is:
Full-Scale Score of 130
(Some partial scores of 130 may be considered with acceptable written justification from the examiner.)

NOTE: No further testing is needed if the student does not meet 130 IQ requirement.

Academic Achievement Test

Woodcock-Johnson III or Wechsler Individual Achievement Test-III (Required for consideration for Pine View or Gifted Cluster Sites)

If your child meets the minimum Full-Scale IQ score of 130, administration of either academic achievement test is required.

Woodcock-Johnson III: Tests of Achievement (Form A or B; Normative update required effective January 2008)

The evaluation must report standard scores (age based) for:

- Reading Comprehension Composite
- Broad Math

-OR-

Wechsler Individual Achievement Test-III

The evaluation must report standard scores (age based) for:

- Reading Comprehension and Fluency Composite
- Math Composite

Note: Psychoeducational evaluations by psychologists in private practice are the financial responsibility of the parents. All evaluations from psychologists in private practice are subject to review and verification by Sarasota County School Board staff prior to gifted eligibility determination.

- 3. Gifted Characteristics Scales
 Renzulli's Scales for Rating the
 Behavioral Characteristics of Superior
 Students (revised 1997) are
 completed by at least one of the
 student's current academic teachers.
 Areas rated are learning, creativity,
 motivation and leadership. The
 student must display a majority of
 characteristics to be considered for
 a gifted program. These forms are
 provided by your child's district
 school.
- 4. Report Card Grades
 Grades are required for reading
 and math. Submit report cards that
 cover the most recent grading
 periods that span one year.

GIFTED ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION

Gifted eligibility encompasses the following three requirements:

- 1. A full-scale IQ of 130 and
- 2. A majority of characteristics on a gifted rating scale <u>and</u>
- 3. A need for gifted services

A student who meets <u>all three</u> requirements is eligible for the gifted program at his or her district school.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PINE VIEW AND GIFTED CLUSTER PROGRAMS

Eligibility determination for <u>Pine View</u> and <u>Gifted Cluster Programs</u> requires <u>additional</u> academic achievement testing.

If the student qualifies for gifted, according to the previous criteria, then achievement scores and report card grades are entered on the full-time eligibility form to determine if the student meets criteria for Pine View or a Gifted Cluster Site.

All files are processed by the Exceptional Student Education (ESE) Liaison at your child's district school. Your district school is determined by your Sarasota County address.

Only complete files, with proof of residency submitted to your child's district school by the deadline date, April 27, 2012, will be accepted for eligibility determination.

DEADLINE DATES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED

- 1. For consideration to Pine View you must adhere to the April 27, 2012, deadline (No Exceptions).
- 2. For consideration to Gifted Cluster Sites, the deadline is extended to Thursday, August 18, 2012.

NOTE: If a reevaluation of a student's academic achievement is conducted within 12 months of the previous achievement testing, then both academic areas (reading and math) must be reevaluated in order to obtain a current assessment of the student's academic profile.

To avoid a test/retest policy violation, an alternative academic achievement test must be administered.

The most current reading and math scores will be used in determining full-time gifted program eligibility.

DEADLINE DATES

Friday April 27, 2012

Students who are moving to Sarasota County must submit complete files containing the psycho-educational report (IQ and academic achievement tests), gifted rating scales, report cards and proof of residency to the district school that serves your Sarasota address, no later than April 27, 2012. If the student qualifies for full-time gifted services and their file is received after April 27, 2012, Pine View placement will not be a gifted program option. Gifted eligibility cannot be determined for students who do not present proof of residency.

Tuesday, June 5, 2012

Proof of residency in Sarasota County must be established.

Thursday, August 18, 2012

Last date for consideration to Gifted Cluster Sites.
