Nationally, the highest dropout rate is with students transitioning to ninth grade.  Phoenix Academy has a diverse population and serves students throughout Sarasota County as a public school of choice. Seventy-five percent of the students are on free and reduced lunch, which qualifies the school for Title 1 identification and therefore academic funding. Phoenix Academy is the only Title 1 high school in Sarasota County.  Positive Behavior Support is based on the belief that school staff members in all settings actively teach and consistently recognize and reinforce appropriate behavior. Effective incentives and motivational systems are provided to encourage students to behave appropriately instead of facing the alternative of punitive actions for misbehaviors.
