(Not grant activities) The purpose of this grant is to boost student achievement in the area of reading. This project focuses on our emergent readers in the primary grades so that a strong foundation is set for their school careers. The shift moves from "learning to read" to "reading to learn" as they approach the intermediate grades. Understanding what they read will increase student achievement in all content areas; fluency is the bridge between word recognition and comprehension. Young readers will work on accuracy, pace, smoothness and phrasing. Another objective is to also expand their vocabulary and word meaning base which will increase comprehension. This is crucial with the number of economically disadvantaged children at our school as well as our ESE/ESOL population. Briefly list grant program activities (what is going to be done with the grant funds): Florida Studio Theatre teaching artists will provide six workshops in each first and second grade classroom. Children will participate in various theatre games and exercises that will enhance the young students reading skills. Some of these skills are expanding vocabulary, finding the main idea, learning elements of plot and fluency. Please provide a brief explanation of pertinent budget items that will be funded through this grant. The grant will provide for the contracted services of Florida Studio Theatre teaching artists for each of our first and second grade classrooms. Reader's Theatre will be scheduled for six visits per classroom over a three month period.										
How will grant activities be continued after the end of grant period? Teachers and other staff members will be in the classrooms for the workshops. It is a valuable experience for staff as well as the students. Activities and exercises will be modeled and can then be integrated throughout the curriculum. Reader's Theatre scripts are available to teachers from a variety of resources and they will have gained strategies to implement these in class. Teachers will have these skills to draw upon in subsequent school years.
