Attached, please find school enrollments from 2007-2008 through what has been projected for 2015-2016. The gifted students are recorded in the FEFP program as Students with Disabilities, along with all other students identified as 251 through 253.

#### Historical Data at Cluster Sites from 2007-2008 to Present

Fruitville Elementary has remained at 5 gifted teachers for the whole entire time. Venice Elementary has remained at 7 gifted teachers the whole entire time. Booker Middle had 6 teachers and this year reduced by 2 for a total of 4 gifted teachers. Sarasota Middle had 8 gifted teachers and this year increased to 9 gifted teachers.

Pine View has remained steady and below 2,250 student population. During 2008-09 the district office established procedures to process all requests for full-time gifted clusters and Pine View. This practice was discontinued on 2010-11 after determining that we were not exceeding capacity at Pine View or any of our full-time cluster sites.

- Informational brochures clearly delineate the process for eligibility and services.
- We continue to educate the community with the process of eligibility and services.
- We continue to provide on-going training to ESE Liaisons on process, requirements and eligibility for gifted services.
