### SCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT TEST (SAT) AND AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST (ACT) RESULTS

### ACT/SAT


- Both the ACT and SAT are offered 7 times annually.
- The following results are based on the annual report of the prior year's graduating cohort. The latest cohort report for the SAT is from 2016; the latest report for the ACT is from 2017.
- Students can use the ACT/SAT results in lieu of passing the Grade 10 FSA Reading Assessment.

### SAT

### SCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT TEST

- The SAT contains three multiple-choice subtests—Reading, Writing, and Mathematics—and an optional essay.
- These tests are designed to measure skills that are most important for success in postsecondary education and that are acquired in secondary education.
- The score range for the Reading and Writing section, and Mathematics section is 200-800. The essay score range is from 2-8.
- The total score range is 400 1600 which is the sum of the Reading and Writing section and Mathematics section.


#### SAT READING MEAN SCORES 2012-2016



### SAT READING MEAN SCORES

- The Sarasota County District's average score was 57 points higher than the state for SAT Reading.
- The SAT Reading scores for 2016 indicate that Pine View School had the highest average scores in the district followed by Booker High School.
- The most improved school in the district for SAT Reading scores from 2015-2016 was Venice High School with an increase of 15 points.


#### SAT MATHEMATICS MEAN SCORES 2012-2016



### SAT MATHEMATICS MEAN SCORE

- The Sarasota County District's average score was 60 points higher than the state for SAT Mathematics.
- Since 2012, district SAT mathematics scores have steadily increased by 14 points. The state has steadily decreased 17 points.
- For all three years Pine View surpassed all other schools in the district. Riverview had the second highest average of SAT Mathematics scores for the years of 2014-2016.
- Pine View demonstrated a 17 point average score increase from 2015 to 2016. Booker High School showed a 14 point increase during this period.

### SAT WRITING MEAN SCORES


- The district averaged 52 points higher than the state on SAT Writing in 2016.
- Pine View School recorded the highest scores for SAT Writing for the years of 2014-2016. Riverview High School recorded the second highest scores for SAT Writing.

Venice High School increased 21 points in their average SAT Writing scores from 2015-2016. The Suncoast Polytechnical High School increased 20 points.

### ACT AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST

- The ACT contains four multiple-choice tests—English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science—and an optional writing test.
- These tests are designed to measure skills that are most important for success in postsecondary education and that are acquired in secondary education.
- The score range for each of the four multiple-choice tests is 1–36.
- The ACT Composite Score is the average of the four test scores rounded to the nearest whole number.

### ACT COMPOSITE MEAN SCORES

- For the years of 2013-2017, the district averaged a minimum of 1.4 points higher than the state.
- Over the past three years , the district's composite score has steadily increased to 21.9 points in 2017. The state has declined slightly.
- Pine View recorded the highest average composite scores in the district followed by Riverview High School and Suncoast Polytechnical High School.
- All schools increased their composite score from 2016 to 2017 except North Port High School which dropped one tenth of a point.

### ACT ENGLISH MEAN SCORES

- The district averaged a minimum of 1.5 points more than the state for the years of 2013-2017.
- Pine View School earned the highest average ACT English scores in the district for the years of 2015-2017 followed by Suncoast Polytechnical High School, and Riverview High School.
- All schools increased their ACT scores from 2016 to 2017 with Riverview High School showing the highest increase of 1.2 points.

### ACT READING MEAN SCORES

- Over the past five years, Sarasota County has outperformed the state by a minimum of 1.2 points. In 2017, Sarasota County was 1.8 points higher than the state average.
- The district's ACT Reading scores have been steadily increasing. The average score was 22.8 in 2017.
- Pine View School earned the highest ACT Reading scores in the district for the years of 2015-2017, followed by Riverview High School and Suncoast Polytechnical High School.
- Riverview High School showed the most improvement from 2016-2017 at .8 of a point.

### ACT MATHEMATICS MEAN SCORES

- Over the past five years, Sarasota County has outperformed the state by a minimum of 1.4 points. In 2017, Sarasota county was 2.2 points higher than the state average.
- The district's ACT Mathematics scores have been steadily increasing since 2015, achieving an average score of 21.6 in 2017. The state's scores have declined since 2015.
- Pine View School had the highest ACT mathematics scores for the years of 2015-2017 followed by Riverview High School and the Suncoast Polytechnical High School.
- The Suncoast Polytechnical High School had the most improved ACT Mathematics score in the district from 2016-2017 with an increase of .7 of a point.

# MULTIPLE STUDENT GROUPS BENEFIT from SCHOOL SPONSORED PREPARATION for the SAT and ACT

- First time test-takers preparing for college entry
- Students who want to raise their previous scores for college entry purposes
- Students who need to test for concordant purposes in order to graduate high school

### **TEST PREPARATION ACTIVITIES**

#### Booker

- Preparation focuses on the ACT, which has proven most successful for their students.
- Preparation sessions are offered during and after school on an optional basis for students who have already met the graduation requirements for English Language (ELA) and Mathematics.
- Students needing to test for concordant purposes attend preparation classes once per week through their Intensive Language Arts (ILA) classes. It is voluntary, but students who refuse are counseled and parents are contacted to discuss the urgency of earning a concordant score.

#### Venice

- Preparation classes are offered after school and promoted in ILA classes.
- Administration meets with at risk seniors individually to discuss opportunities.

### **TEST PREPARATION ACTIVITIES**

#### North Port

- A number of in-house activities are offered to include: 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade ILA class preparation using ACHIEVE; College and Career lab preparation and several in-house weekly courses.
- A USF trainer was hired this year to conduct two training sessions in 17-18.
- An additional SAT assessment during the school day was scheduled in March.

#### Riverview

- "Bootcamps" for seniors who have not passed the FSA Reading graduation assessment are offered.
- Fee-based SAT preparation classes are offered after school for students who are using scores for college admission purposes.

### **TEST PREPARATION ACTIVITIES**

#### **Pine View**


- Promotes using Khan Academy, a free tutorial program through College Board. Students have their PSAT scores linked and the tutorial is personalized to their needs.
- ACT mock exams are offered twice per year in the Fall and Spring.
- PSAT is offered to 8, 9, 10, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students at no charge.
- Fee-based test preparation programs are advertised as they become available.

### **TEST PREPARATION CHALLENGES**


- Students in need will have the test fees reduced or eliminated. Students may utilize ACT/SAT waivers, but each school has a limited number available.
- Schools must solicit funds for test preparation trainers and activities from outside sources to include the Education Foundation, grants, the Rotary and other sources.
- Constant monitoring and communication with students and parents emphasizing the necessity of attending preparation sessions and signing up for waivers – especially for students who need the concordant scores to graduate.

#### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS SAT READING MEAN SCORES 2014-2016




#### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS SAT MATHEMATICS MEAN SCORES 2014-2016



#### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS SAT WRITING MEAN SCORES 2014-2016




### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT COMPOSITE MEAN SCORES 2015-2017



### ACT ENGLISH MEAN SCORES 2013-2017 DISTRICT AND STATE




### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT ENGLISH MEAN SCORES 2015-2017



#### ACT MEAN READING SCORES 2013-2017 DISTRICT AND STATE




### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT READING MEAN SCORES 2015-2017



### ACT MATHEMATICS MEAN SCORES 2013-2017 DISTRICT AND STATE





### SARASOTA COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT MATHEMATICS MEAN SCORE 2015-2017
